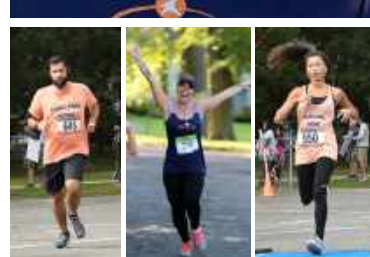
## GIVING BACK TO OUR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
